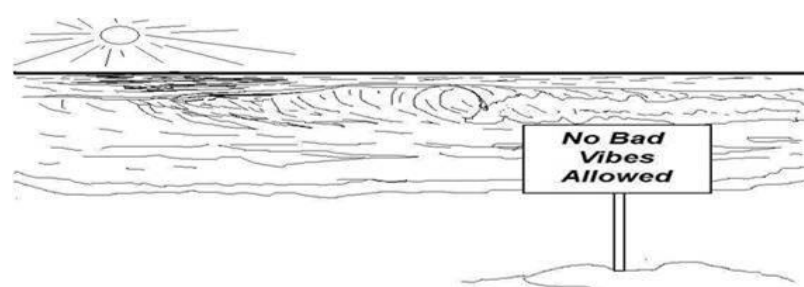

Who we are: Surfers seeking to love God and to love our surfing community. All who desire the same are welcome to join us regardless of where they are on their journey.

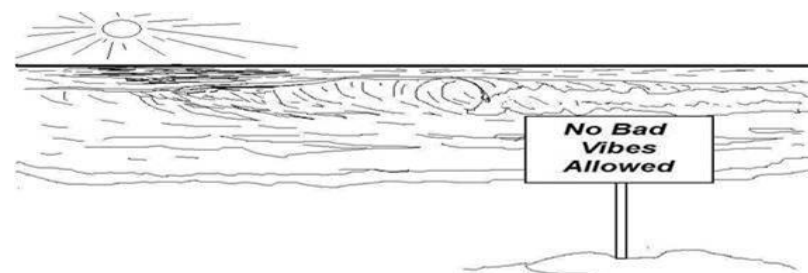

Tips on Surfing Etiquette
